Lockout Lockdown Evacuate Shelter



LOCKOUT!

Secure the Perimeter



LOCKDOWN!

Locks, Lights, Out of Sight.



EVACUATE!

To a Location



SHELTER!

For a Hazard Using a Safety Strategy



WHY LOCKDOWN?



Something dangerous inside
the building

LOCKDOWN!

Locks, Lights, Out of Sight.



STUDENTS

Stay out of sight of the corridor window



STUDENTS

Be silent



STUDENTS

Do not open the door for anyone

**4-NOT VISIBLE, NO MOVEMENT,
NO SOUND AT ALL**
