Senior Recognition

The school district will recognize the outstanding academic achievement of its graduating seniors in the following manner:

The senior student with the highest four-year scholastic grade point average (GPA) shall be declared the class valedictorian; the student with the next highest GPA will be declared the salutatorian. Both the valedictorian and the salutatorian must have attended Freeman High School for their entire junior and senior year and must have attended an accredited public, private, denominational, or parochial school for a period of eight semesters. Any deviation from this requirement must be approved by the superintendent of schools. Students who complete the requirements for graduation and hold an accumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.75 or above shall be considered to have graduated "With Honors." Senior speakers at the Commencement Ceremonies shall be selected from all students who graduate "With Honors." Students will audition with partial speeches to a committee including the principal, class sponsor, and a group of teachers. The satisfactory completion of disciplinary action, payment of fees, payment of school lunches, etc. are part of further graduation requirements.
