

FREEMAN ATHLETICS FALL SEASONS PLAN

Freeman will follow the current state-mandated DHM and NSAA guidelines which we anticipate will remain in place for the foreseeable future. 75% capacity for outdoor events 50% of capacity for indoor events, and maintaining 6' distancing measures at all times.

- Each student athlete (participant and cheerleader) will be allowed a predetermined number of family members and friends to attend each event. Those predetermined individuals will be asked to pay the regular Freeman ticket prices.
- There will be no Family Passes sold for the fall sports season.
- Face coverings for family members attending the game are highly recommended but not required. Our hope is that all family members consider wearing face coverings when entering/exiting the venue, walking to your seat, and when using the restroom and concession stand.
- Cheerleaders at home events only, Freeman Cheer will not travel
- Athletes and coaches that are not competing on the court or field are asked to wear a face covering.
- The school will designate a certain number of open seats reserved for Freeman students in an isolated student section. Students sitting in the student section will be required to wear a face covering.
- Freeman secondary students will have the opportunity to sign up for open seats in the student section prior to the contest. Elementary students may be included in a family/friend group but **MUST** remain seated with the group.
- Per the NSAA, the home school is responsible for setting the guidelines regarding seating capacity and specific precautions. Freeman will communicate those guidelines with coaches, players, and visiting schools. Based on the seating allowances given to us by host schools, we will work with our coaches and players to allow families and fans to attend.
- Visiting team will be given an allotment of seats for each contest that will be determined by venue
- Visiting teams will provide the home school with a pass list of a predetermined number of seats. Admission fee will be required for entrance into games.

Please note: If the local DHM changes to a more restrictive measure, there is a possibility that we may have to further limit seating or cancel future contests.

Please note: Failure to follow social distancing and or face covering requirements **MAY** result in the removal of a person from a contest, a possible removal of a person for an entire sports season, or the removal of a person from ALL freeman activities for the 2020-2021 school year

FALCON STADIUM-

We will follow the most current DHM mandates and guidance from the NSAA when available.

75% capacity and maintaining 6' distancing between family groups

Fans are asked to leave stadium and parking area as soon as the game is over, and not gather post game

- Seating capacity (Stadium seating)
 - Home Fans, Game workers, Officials- 300
 - Visiting Fans 100
 - Students 100
 - No stadium or hillside entry without being on the predetermined pass list & admission
 - To protect our student athletes, families and fans, we ask that people who are not on the pass list, watch the game via the Freeman STRIV TV channel - Designated elderly parking lot viewing only

- Freeman Football Team and Cheerleaders will be allotted 8 seats for family and friends. Players will be responsible for submitting names to the athletic department by the end of the day the day before the game.
- Cheerleaders will be socially distanced on track, face coverings will be worn if they cannot socially distance.
- Visiting School will be allotted 100 seats for fans including students, the visiting school will provide a list of names for the allotted 100 seats. Normal Freeman admission fee will be charged at the gate.
- Visiting School will monitor their own students and fans for compliance of safety measures.
- Family groups must sit together
- Family groups asked to stay 6' from other groups when possible.
- Face coverings for family members attending the game are highly recommended but not required. Our hope is that all family members consider wearing face coverings when they enter/exit the venue, walking to your seat, use the restroom and the concession stand.
- Student section will be a designated area of the stadium and face coverings will be required.
- Student section will be opened up to students prior to contest, students will sign up during lunch the two days prior to the contest. (1PM deadline) Students must remain in designated section during the contest, if you leave the stadium, you will not be re-admitted.
- Standing room and hillside seating for adults allowed while maintaining distancing. Face coverings are highly recommended.
- Only team, medical, & media personnel on the field prior, during and post contest

- Concessions
 - VARSITY CONTESTS ONLY
 - Pre Packaged items will be sold (pop, candy etc...)
 - Workers wear face coverings and gloves
 - Markings on the ground to ensure social distancing in lines
 - Concession staff must maintain social distancing wherever possible.

- No tailgating
- No soup suppers/grill out meals
- Band- Possible only under specific NDE music guidelines.
- Press Box
 - Essential workers only
 - Face coverings if safe distance is not possible
- Transportation
 - All students, activity drivers and sponsors will be required to wear a face covering if proper distancing cannot occur within the bus.

50% capacity and maintaining 6' distancing between family groups

- Home seating on west side, please use west entrance
 - Maintain 6' distancing from family groups
 - NO seating on first row of bleachers
 - NO Standing in entry hallway by patrons
- Visitor seating, on east side, please use west gym entrance
 - Maintain 6' distancing from family groups
 - NO seating on first two row of bleachers and two rows behind teams & score table
 - NO Standing in entry hallway by patrons/fans
 - **NO Lockers rooms will be available, please come dressed**
- Visiting School will be allotted 150 seats for fans including students, the visiting school will provide a list of names for the allotted 150 seats. Normal Freeman admission fee will be charged at the gate.
- Visiting School will monitor their own students and fans for compliance of safety measures.
- No visiting cheerleaders
- Family groups must sit together JH Students are asked to sit with their families
- Family groups asked to stay 6' from other groups when possible.
- Face coverings for fans & family members attending the game are highly recommended but not required. Our hope is that all family members consider wearing face coverings when they enter/exit the venue, walking to your seat, use the restroom and the concession stand.

- Home seating on south side, please use west entrance
 - Maintain 6' distancing from family groups
 - NO seating on first row of bleachers
 - Designated Student Section, Face coverings required
- Visitor seating, on north side, please use north gym entrance
 - Visiting School to provide a list of up to 150 fans
 - Maintain 6' distancing from family groups
 - No seating on first two rows of bleachers
 - **NO Locker rooms will be available, please come dressed**
- Visiting School will be allotted 150 seats for fans including students, the visiting school will provide a list of names for the allotted 150 seats. Normal Freeman admission fee will be charged at the gate.
- Visiting School will monitor their own students and fans for compliance of safety measures.
- Please no visiting cheerleaders
- Freeman cheerleaders will cheer with masks
- Family groups must sit together
- Family groups asked to stay 6' from other groups when possible.
- Face coverings for family members attending the game are highly recommended but not required. Our hope is that all family members consider wearing face coverings when they enter/exit the venue, walking to your seat, use the restroom and the concession stand.

 - Teams will not flip ends and benches

 - VARSITY CONTESTS ONLY
 - Pre Packaged items will be sold (pop, candy etc...)
 - Workers wear masks and gloves
 - No Parent volunteers
 - Markings on the ground to ensure social distancing in lines
 - Concession staff must maintain social distancing wherever possible.
 - NO ice available for team water bottles
- No Soup suppers/Team carry in meals
- No Pep Band

75% capacity and maintaining 6' distancing between family groups

Fans are asked to leave field and parking area as soon as the game is over, and not gather post game

- Capacity 375
 - Freeman Fans,players, coaches & workers- 200
 - Freeman students 75
 - Visiting team- 100 predetermined Fans.
- Seating for fans will be very limited in bleachers, we ask that fans bring chairs and spread out down your respective baselines.
- Freeman Softball Players and will be allotted 8 seats for family
- Freeman students will be allotted 75 seats, they will be able to sign up the day before the game during lunch.
- Visiting School will be asked to provide list of up to 100 fans including students
- Visiting School will monitor their own students and fans for compliance to safety measures
- Family groups must sit together
- Face coverings for fans & family members attending the game are highly recommended but not required. Our hope is that all family members consider wearing face coverings when they enter/exit the venue, walking to your seat, use the restroom and the concession stand. .
