ADMISSION	\$5 Adults - Due to Covid and indoor capacity limits - we will allow 1 parent per athlete. We will print off a roster of each team and will mark the parent off when they attend.
START TIME:	10:00 A.M / Weigh ins will begin at 8 a.m. by team in the Tiger Arena. The weigh in rules will be enforced, please be on time.
SEEDING:	The seeding meeting will be held the morning of the 12 th @ 8:00 a.m. in our Choir room at North Bend Central and we ask for 1 coach only to attend.
PARKING:	Buses are to park on the south side of the school in the west side of the parking lot in the rock area, or use the far side of the parking lot nearest the softball field.
CONCESSIONS:	Due to adjustments made for Corona, our concession stand choices are reduced and changed from past years. Our prices have gone up marginally as well. We will also have areas marked off in regards to lines.
SEATING:	Each team will be assigned a section that will be clearly marked with a sign in both gyms. We will ask that your wrestlers and your parents sit in only the section that is marked for your squad.
TEAM LOCATION:	Your team will receive a sectioned and labeled area in each gym that is to be their home. We will have a rotating schedule for locker rooms for showers. There will be multiple restrooms available for athletes.
FORMAT:	Each wrestler entered in the tournament will be seeded according to criteria. A traditional 16 - man, double elimination format tournament will be conducted using Track Wrestling. We will allow JV wrestlers to be entered into weight brackets that are not full. North Bend Central JV wrestlers will have the first opportunity to fill a bracket.

- MATCH FORMAT:** First round and championship matches in the bracket will be 2-2-2, and consolation matches in the bracket will be 1-2-2.
- TEAM SCORING:** **Advancement Points:** 2 Points for advancement in championship matches and 1 point for advancement in consolation matches.
Bonus Points: 2 points for a pin, 1.5 points for a tech fall, 1 point for a major decision.
Placement Points: 14 for 1st Place, 10 for 2nd place, 7 for 3rd place, and 4 for 4th place.
- MATS:** Due to Covid adjustments will be operating with 4 mats and two gyms. We will have the 106 - 145 weight class on the two mats in the OLD GYM and the 152 - Heavyweights on the two man in Tiger Arena.
- AWARDS:** We will be sending out all medals and trophies through the mail to all schools as there will not be an awards ceremony at the conclusion of the Invite.
There will be team trophies for first and second place. Individual medals for the first four places.
- TOWELS:** There will be no sharing or using of others personal equipment. You are in charge of your own towels or other personal equipment.
- EATING:** We will allow the athletes to bring their own coolers of food into their designated seating areas. We would ask that throw away any and all trash. We would ask that all parents also follow the same procedures with any food. Eating in the gym is not preferable, but due to Covid and space it is what we can do. Please operate accordingly.
- SANCTION:** NSAA approved.
- LOCKERS:** There will be a locker room rotation for each school. Four schools will share each locker room and we would ask that coaches monitor that their athletes only use the locker room at assigned times. Please see attached sheet for rotation. This will also be post outside each locker room.
